Vandiyur MariammanTheppakulam is one of the biggest HeritageTemple Tanks of South India, constructed by the King Thirumalai Nayak during **1635**. He named it as **Thirumalai NayakarSamuthiram**. This heritage tank with the Mandapam situated at the Center exhibits beauty of Nayak building architecture.

DHAN Foundation in collaboration with INTACH (Madurai Chapter), Travel Club (Madurai), and Madurai Vattara Kalanjiyam (Madurai) has organized the heritage walk with the technical support of Dr.V.Vedachalam (Archaeologist) and Dr.G.Sethuraman (Art Historian).
