BANSWARA REGION

In Banswara district, DHAN Foundation is working in 7 blocks viz., Kushalgarh, Sajjangarh, Gangratali, Anandpuri, Banswara and Bagidora. DHAN Foundation initiated the CFL Pilot Project on 1st July 2019 in five tribal blocks viz., Bagidora, Anandpuri, Gangartalai, Kushalgarh and Sajjangarh, funded by RBI in collaboration with Bank of Baroda, the lead bank for Banswara District. DHAN Foundation is working in 169 villages with 1,84,831 members for providing financial literacy awareness. Banswara is one of the most tribal populous districts in the state.

EFFECT OF COVID-19

In Banswara, there are 12 confirmed cases. Out of which six are from Kushalgarh. Presently, Kushalgarh is announced as risk prone area; the location is having maximum migrants from Udaipur. In one family, father (55 years) and son (16 years) contracted the virus. Total family got infected now and one of the women in the family died. As result, 19 families are quarantined.
