DHAN Foundation's Gaya region works with 4950 families. 50 to 60% of the male members (husband /son) of our Kalanjiam families are working in various states viz., Nadu, Tamil Kerala, Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Ranchi, Bengaluru etc., involved in various livelihood activities like manufacturing industry, cloth shop labor work. Due the and to lockdown, 30-40% struck at their workplace.

Livelihood Impact

Out of 4950 migrant families, DHAN staff reached 1287 families over phone. They are staying at eight different states. They had been employed in various livelihood activities but due to lockdown they are facing the financial crisis

Other side of lockdown is Manpur block has become pollution free block especially free from Nosie pollution
