









## Madurai Heritage Walk at Historic Samanamalai 12.1.2020 Sunday







Sanmanamalai hill lies in the village Keelakuilkudi, 15km west of Madurai near Nagamalai Pudukottai. The name of the hill itself explains its association with Jainism Jainism existed here from 300 BC with the Brahmi inscription belongs to 200 BC. In this village three important Jain vestiges are found which speak about the existence and flourishing nature of Jainism during 9-10 Century A.D. It is a picturesque place with a lotus pond at the foot of the hill Samanamalai.
